

Coupon Lingo Cheat Sheet

- **\$1/1, \$2/1, etc.:** One dollar off 1, Two dollars off 1, etc.
- **B5G5, B4S4:** Kroger Mega Sales, Buy 5 Save \$5, Buy 4 save \$4
- **Blinkies:** In store coupon machines next to product that blinks
- **BOGO:** Buy one get one
- **CAT:** Catalina (prints at register)
- **ECB:** Extra care bucks (CVS only)
- **Deal Matchups/ Ad Matchups:** Combining a manufacturer coupon with a store sale (only way you will get a good deal with coupons)
- **Insert:** Coupon booklet that came in newspaper (i.e. SS, RP, P&G)
- **IP:** Internet printable
- **MFC:** Manufacturer coupon
- **MM:** Moneymaker
- **NLA:** No longer available
- **OOP:** Out of pocket
- **Overage:** When the coupon amount is higher than the item sale price, you can apply the overage to your basket.
- **OYNO:** On your next order
- **P&G:** Procter & Gamble
- **Peelie:** Sticker coupon found on item
- **Piggybacking:** \$ off "Your Basket" coupons can be combined with an item level coupon (HEB allows this)
- **PM:** Price match
- **Q:** Coupon
- **RP:** Red Plum
- **SS:** Smart Source
- **Stacking:** Using a store coupon and a manufacturer coupon
- **TP:** Tear pad
- **Wags:** Walgreens
- **WYB:** When you buy
- **YMMV:** Your miles may vary (price varies by location)
